

Transition services are COOrdinated set of activities for a student with a disability.

- * It is designed within an <u>outcome-oriented</u>
 <u>process</u>, which promotes movement from school to post-school activities, including but not limited to;
 - post secondary education,
 - vocational training,
 - integrated employment (including supported employment),
 - continuing and adult education,
 - adult services,
 - independent living, or
 - community participation;

- Based on the <u>individual student's needs</u>, taking into account the <u>student's preferences</u> and interests; and
- Includes →
 - A. Instruction
 - **B.** Related Services
 - **C.** Community Experiences
 - The development of employment and other post-school adult living objectives; and
 - E. If appropriate, acquisition of <u>daily</u>
 <u>living skills</u> and <u>functional vocational</u>
 <u>evaluation</u>.


